Course: 8 lanes 50M pool with 25M warm down pool.

The age of the swimmer on December 31, 2004 will determine the age group in which the swimmer is eligible to swim.

\* In the open events the minimum age is 11 years old.

Coaches are asked to submit their scratches on Friday May 27<sup>th</sup>, 1 hour prior to the start of the session.

### • Registration & Entries

Each club must submit a letter of sanction from its National Federation indicating that participating swimmers and clubs are registered members and are in good financial standing.

Entries must be made on the entry form which accompanies this Summons. The entries must be returned to the Organizing Committee by Tuesday, May 17th 2005, at the following address:

The **NO FALSE START RULE** will be in effect in accordance with FINA rules SW 4:1 and SW 4:4.

**The following SHALL apply to all entries:**

1. There is no limit to the number of swimmers which your club can enter in an event, however only the two highest placed swimmers in your club will score points.
2. Each Club may enter a maximum of two (2) teams per relay event.
3. There shall be no restrictions on the number of events in which an individual competitor may participate.
4. Heats will be announced and swimmers missing their respective heat will not be allowed to take part in that event.
5. Swimmers competing in relay events must be registered in the meet.
6. There shall be no substitutes nor alternates in individual events.
7. Deck entries **WILL NOT** be accepted.
8. Swimmers must be in the waiting area at least 20 minutes before the start of the event in which the swimmer has been entered.

• **Awards**

Medals will be awarded to the first three (3) swimmers and Ribbons from 4th to 8th place in each event.

The team scoring the highest overall points shall be the winning team and shall have its name inscribed on the Aquatic Centre International Trophy. A replica of this trophy will be given to the team to take home. Trophies will be given to the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed teams in the competition. Additionally there will be a trophy awarded to the highest placed team within the OECS

grouping. Team trophies will be presented following the last event and Ribbons and Medals will be given to team delegates. Scoring shall be as follows:

First Place - 9 points  
Second Place - 7 points  
Third Place - 6 points  
Fourth Place - 5 points  
Fifth Place - 4 points  
Sixth Place - 3 points  
Seven Place - 2 points  
Eight Place - 1 point

Please note: Double points for relays.

- **Entry fees** : US\$10.00 per swimmer up to 5 events  
US\$ 2.00 for each additional event  
There is no entry limit
- : US\$ 5.00 per relay team
- : Entry fees **must** accompany your entry form.  
However in the case of participants from overseas entry fees must be paid on arrival.

- **Technical Officials**

The Barbados Amateur Swimming Association in conjunction with the Affiliated swim clubs in Barbados will provide the Officials for the competition. Overseas clubs are invited to submit the names of any qualified persons willing to serve as Timekeepers / Judges during the meet, along with their entries.

- **Program**

There shall be no Heats or Preliminaries. All events are Timed Finals. The pool will be open one (1.1/2) hours before each session for warm-up. Please note that warm up will be an open format.

- **Refreshment**

Food and drink will be available on the premises, throughout the meet.
