This year we honuor Angus Edghill & Leah Martindale-Stancil

It is with great pleasure that I welcome you to the Dolphins Swim Club Barbados Inaugural Open Sprint Swimming Championships. This year is special not only because this inaugural competition, but in 2019 Dolphins Swim Club also celebrates 15 years registered with the recently rebranded Barbados Aquatic Sports Association.

This competition is designed to facilitate "The Bridge" between age group and open swimming in our region. In the past, several of our swimmers only experienced open swimming competition at the CAC, Commonwealth or World Championships before the Olympics that are top level competition restricted for elite national athletes only. "The Bridge" seeks to offer opportunity for emerging and elite athletes to be on the same blocks and facilitate memorable maturing experiences. This can only lead to the advancement and maturity of swimmers in this region. The seeding for individual events will be based on times for individual swimmers and no reference will be made to age-groupings (for individual events). For the purpose of inclusion, it is then necessary to now include age group relays to facilitate additional growth in athletes that will enhance the profile of the respective clubs striving for supremacy.

Each year we will be celebrating two Barbadians that have brought honuor to the sport of Swimming and our country. This year we ask you to join us in celebrating Angus Edghill and Leah Martindale-Stancil for their outstanding contribution to the sport of Swimming in Barbados; two Barbadian Swimming lcons. Let us encourage the youth to recognize that through courage, hard

work and perseverance they will unearth the character that leads to success. It is through dreams and vision that great moments are achieved.

This Aquatic Centre exists largely due to the vision of Barbadians who recognized the opportunity that could be afforded to others and for this event we celebrate the contribution of Masters swimmer and former Masters World record holder Angus Edghill for his contribution to the foresight and construction of this facility. Angus Edghill, was Barbados' first swimmer at the 1968 Olympics. Years after in 1992, Angus Edghill broke three world Masters records in the 400m, 800m, and 1500m (long course) freestyle in the 45-49 age group. In 1995, he also broke the 400m and 800m short course freestyle records in the 50-54 age group.

The second recipient of recognition this year goes to our highest national achievement in swimming Olympic history to date that rests solely on Leah Martindale now Martindale-Stancil who was the first Barbadian to achieve entry to the 50m Freestyle Olympic final at the 1996 Atlanta Olympic Games. Her swim remains the Open record for females in Barbados in the 50m Freestyle event. To this end, we are proud to associate the two 'icons' as this competition will assist in educating and reiterate their contribution to our society, the region and beyond.

Over the next two days we welcome record setting, and entry qualifying swims to this and regional competitions.

May these two days of competition heighten the awareness of the reason sport facilitates long lasting friendships, fair play and rewarding life experiences.

ELIGIBILITY: All Swimmers of the F.I.N.A. world. All entry times should have been

achieved within the last twenty-four months. All swimmers entered in this competition are eligible to receive medals and awards as outlined

in this summons.

Swimmers must be entered in individual events to be eligible for any

relay event.

All swimmers entered in the competition are eligible to win medals.

AGE-GROUPINGS For the purpose of relays; age groups are determined by age at

SCRATCHES: Scratches will be accepted up to the technical meeting 6:30p.m.

BDS\$5.00 per event.

ENTRY LIMIT: There is no entry limit for swimmers.

file or Excel spread sheet.

ENTRY FEE: BDS\$50.00 or USD\$25.00 per team meet surcharge.

Relay entries will cost BDS\$20.00 per team (4 swimmers) event.

TEAM SCORES: Only two swimmers in each team can score individual points.

Multiple relay teams can be entered and will be awarded points.

Entries submitted after the deadline date and time outlined in this summons will attract an additional fee of BDS\$5.00 per swimmer or in the case of relays one additional payment of BDS\$10.00 per relay

entry.

PENALTY: Swimmers who do not achieve a time faster that their entry time (or

the minimum entry time) will pay a penalty of BDS\$5.00 per event.

Swimmers who have accumulated penalty fees will not be

allowed to further participate in the swim meet unless the fees

have been paid in full.

(Special note)

As part of our developmental program, Swimmers 8 & Under (age 9)

do not need to achieve the motivational times.

RULES: FINA 2018 – 2020 Rules will apply.

EVENTS: Female events will precede male events.

TEAM REPRESENTATION:

Prior to the start of the meet, the name of one person other than the coach will check with the referee about matters pertaining to the meet, may be given the meet referee. Only the coach and that person will be recognized.

Rules

The current FINA rules will be applicable during this swim meet unless otherwise specified.

Age Groups

- Open to all swimmers who have achieved the qualifying times.
- The time entered shall determine eligibility as minimum seeded times are included to this summons.

Entry Rules

- Individual Events: Each team may enter any number of competitors in each individual
 event but only the first two (2) individuals in any team will score points for their
 respective club.
- Only swimmers entered in individual events can swim in any relay event.
- Relays will be swam in five (5) age groups:

8 & Under, 9 - 10, 11 - 12, 13 - 14, 15 & Older.

 Relay Events: Each team may enter as many relay teams as they desire and all teams will be eligible for points.

Individual:

Medals will be awarded (presented) for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners for both Male and Female events.

Competition Accumulated High Point Trophy

One trophy will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd place swimmer respectively in both male and female category that accumulates the highest total number of points in individual events only at the conclusion of the competition.

FINA Average Quality High point Trophy

Only swimmers that compete in a minimum of four (4) individual events are eligible for this award. 1st, 2nd & 3rd place will be granted to the swimmers both male and female respectively that has achieved the highest FINA points average in four (4) swims. Relay swims will not be eligible.

Team Challenge Shield

1st place will be awarded to the club whose swimmers (both male and female together) have accumulated the highest overall number of points in both individual and relay events and will have their team name scribed on the challenge shield (Team trophy to be kept) that must be returned one month before the next advertised annual event. The 2nd and 3rd place clubs will be given miniature trophy trophies.

Team:

Males and females are not allowed to swim in the same event.

Protest:

All protests against the Referees' decision must be submitted to the Referee in writing within 30 minutes after the event in question. It should be signed by the Delegation's Representative and accompanied by US \$25.00 or BDS\$50.00. The fee is refundable to the leader of the delegation if the protest is upheld.

Jury of Appeal

- A. There shall be a Jury of Appeal to adjudicate all appeals against a Referee's rejection of a protest.
- B. Each club shall be entitled to nominate a representative to serve on the Jury of Appeal. Nominations should be submitted in writing at the 6:30p.m. Technical Meeting on Wednesday 25th September, 2019
- C. The Jury of Appeal shall be comprised of 3 persons that must include one member representative of Barbados Aquatic Sports Association Council, and the other two from nominees submitted by each club.
- D. The representative making the appeal will not be included in the panel selection and must be respectful of the privacy needed to discuss the issue.
